Decisions and Comments

- We investigated the high-water complaint on Lake 12 on May 10, 2024. There appeared to many issues to include a beaver dam on the lake, debris in the ditches on private property along with a drainage issue in our ROW. After talking with the DNR it was determined we could not do anything about the dam. However, they planned to work with the landowners on a resolve. As a Township we were able to take care of our ROW. It appears the water is moving much better now.
- Island Lake outlet discussion. The Township has an easement to maintain the outlet through Pine County Soil and Water. The Windemere Lake Association can also have a role. Conversations are ongoing
- Inquiry about sand sales. Pit boss indicated there is minimal available at this time and no where near ready for any outside sales. Board action
